Guest speaker for series was Mr. Tarani Prakash Shrivastava, Research Associate, Pharmacovigilance at Immunization Technical Support Unit, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, New Delhi. The basic objective of this Lecture series was to sensitize students on “Pharmacogenomics” through which students would be able to learn more about the basic knowledge of Pharmacogenomics, Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), Council for International Organizations of Medical Sciences (CIOMS) with their working and various methods of Drug safety evaluation in special population. Lecture shall also provide students with an understanding of the principles and applications of human genetics and genomics in drug therapy optimization, patient care, and counseling. 


Guideline for Preparing Core Clinical Safety Information on Drugs

- > Harmonize Company Core Safety information (CCSI) by all manufacturers
- > Conceptualize Development Core Safety Information (DCSI)

- Minimizing confusion among investigators, prescribers and other healthcare professionals due to inconsistencies between the drug safety information of different countries and manufacturers;
- Facilitating access to important information for making rational clinical decisions;
- Eliminating the diversity of national alert/expedited reporting requirements of different regulators, which result from differences in what constitute unexpected ("unlabelled") adverse drug reactions.

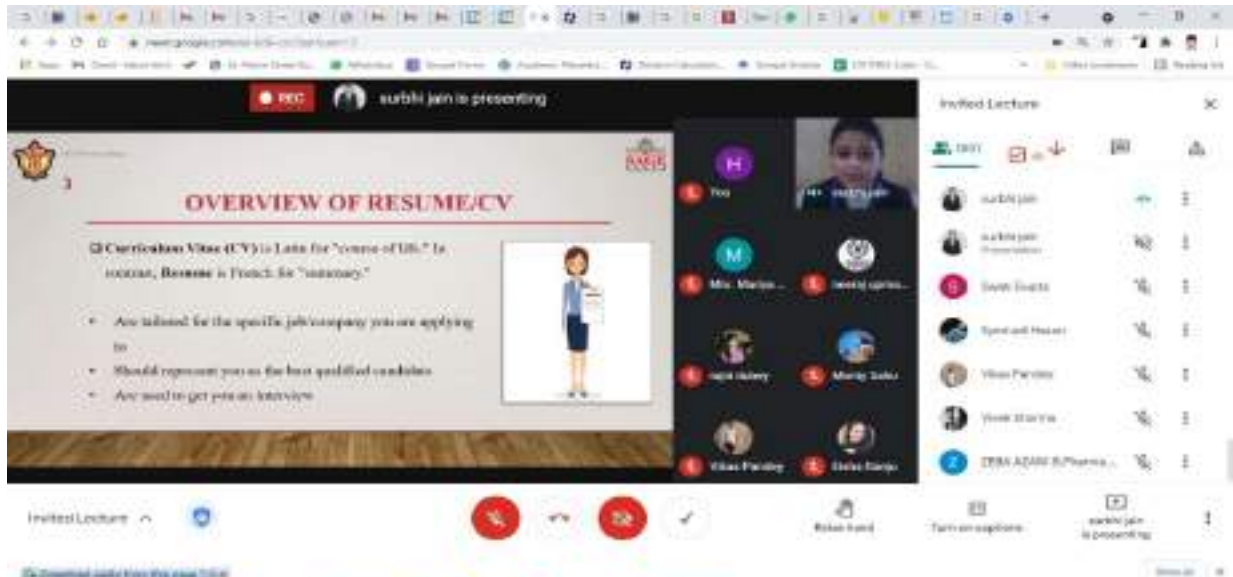
REPORT OF THE EVENT

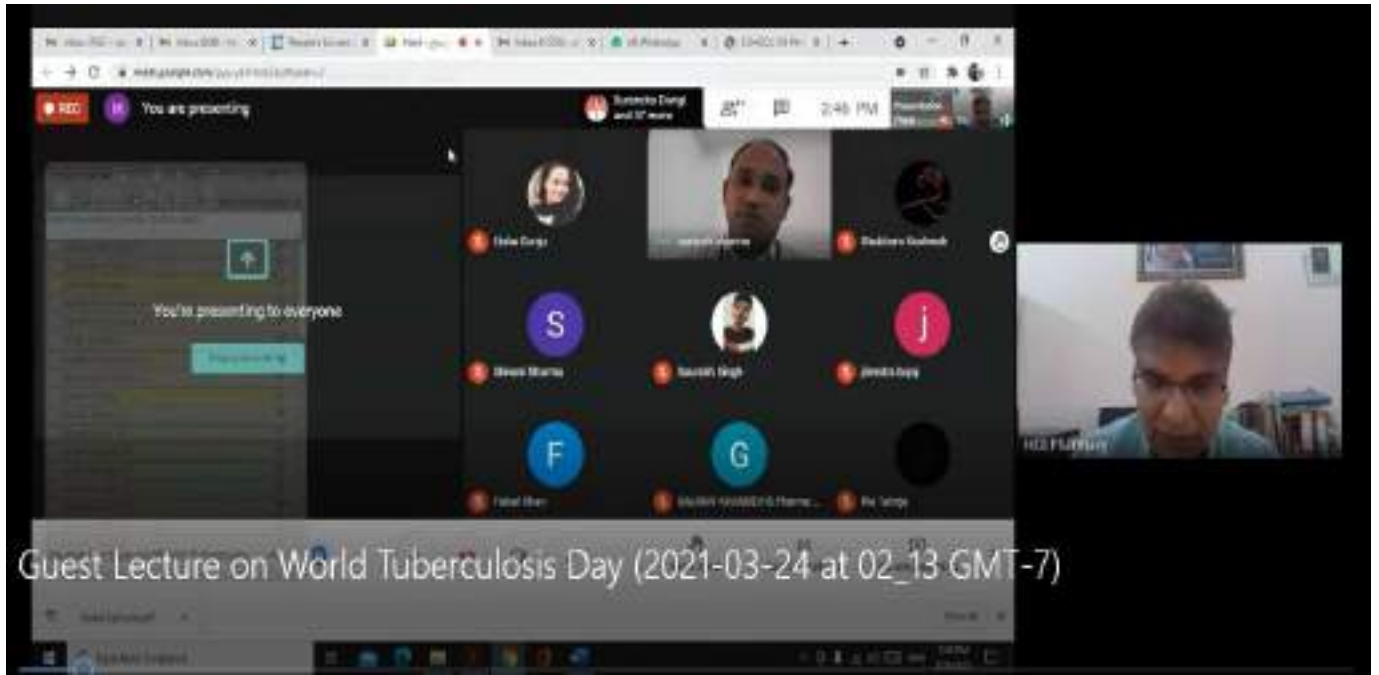
REPORT OF THE EVENT

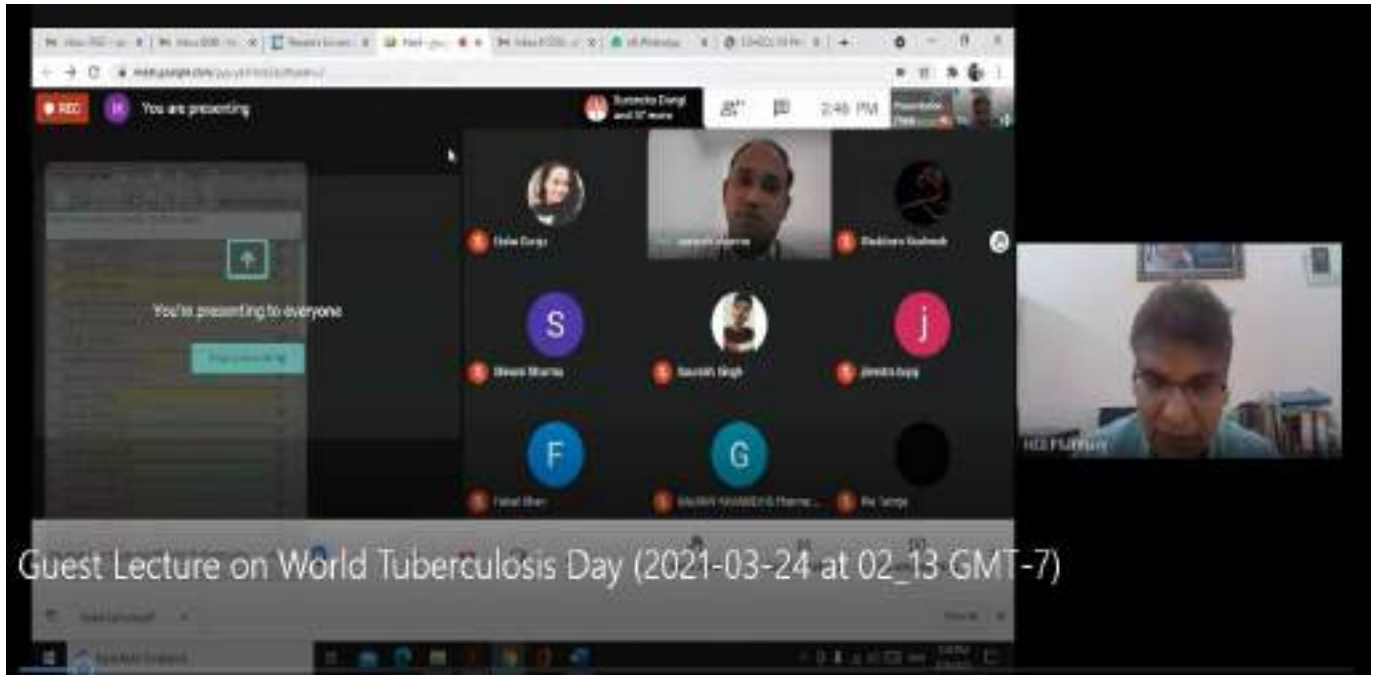

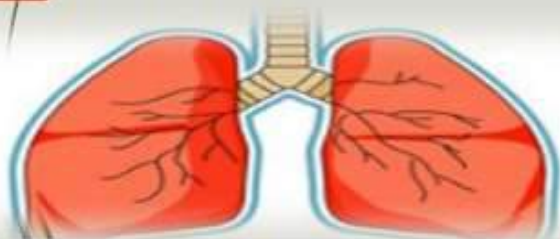

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and re registration procedure and about **NATIONAL ACADEMIC DEPOSITORY (NAD)** in which every students have to register them.



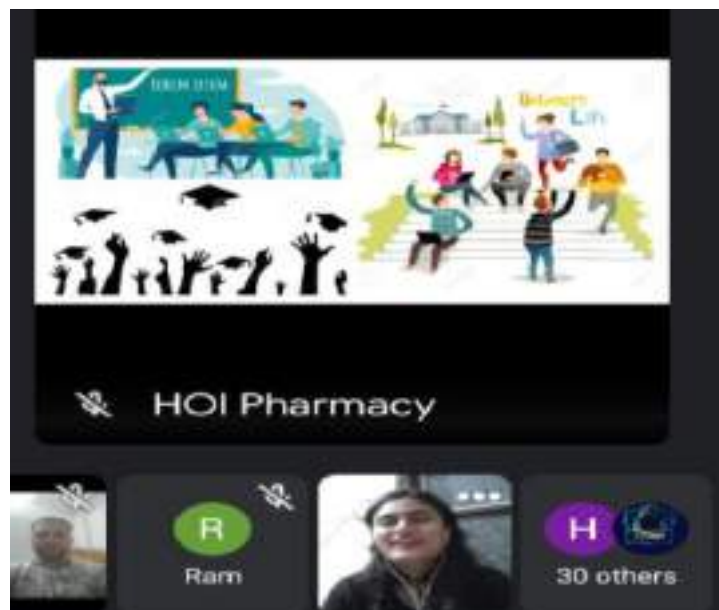
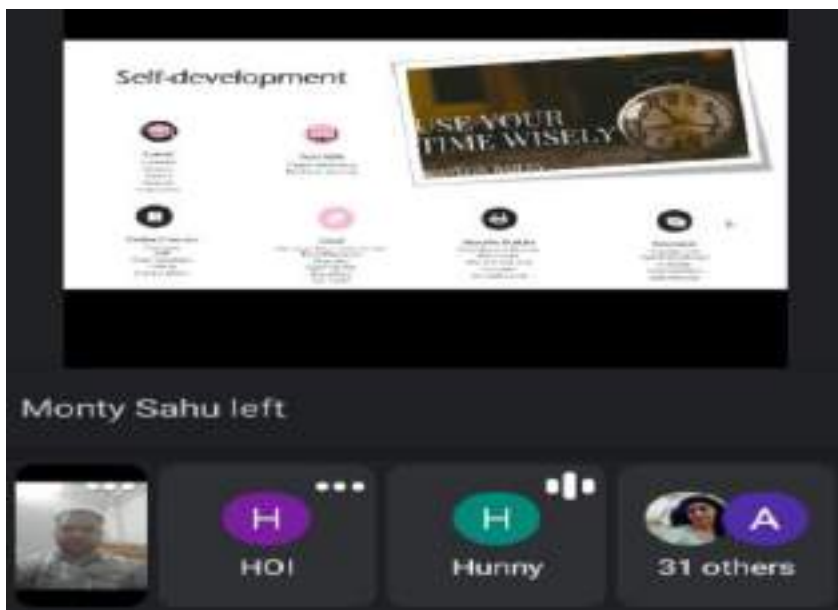
DAY 6 : 31st October
