

Diagnose and treat 40 million people with TB by 2022 including 3.5 million children and 1.5 million people with drug-resistant TB. This is in line with WHO's overall drive towards Universal Health Coverage and the WHO Director General's flagship initiative "24 March" is World Tuberculosis Day. Each year we commemorate World TB Day to raise public awareness about the devastating health, social and economic consequences of tuberculosis (TB) and to step up efforts to end the global TB epidemic. The Stop TB Partnership is sharing today the theme for this year's World TB Day: "Invest to End TB. Save Lives to convey the urgent need to invest resources to ramp up the fight against TB and achieve the commitments to end TB made by global leaders. This is especially critical in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic that has put End TB progress at risk, and to ensure equitable access to prevention and care in line with WHO's drive towards achieving Universal Health Coverage.

Outcome/Impact of event/activity in brief — "Invest to End TB. Save Lives." to build public awareness about the global TB epidemic and efforts to eliminate the disease. because Every day, over 4100 people die from TB and nearly 30 000 people fall ill with TB disease — despite it being preventable and treatable. TB is the leading cause of death of people with HIV and a major contributor to antimicrobial resistance. World TB Day is an opportunity to focus on the people affected by this disease and to call for accelerated action to end TB suffering and deaths, especially in the midst of the ongoing COVID-19 crisis. This type of small initiative will help them for better understanding about the disease and its management.
