1. "Covaxin Vaccination Camp" (14/02/2022) for the age group 15 to 18 years was organized by Mr. Shashikant Sharma, Asso. Professor and Mrs. Meenu Vaidya, Admin Officer jointly with the Office of the Collectorate Bhopal at SORT on 14th February 2022. This camp was organized for the students of SORT to create awareness on the rapid spread of the viral infection and the safety measures to be taken. This was a part of the inoculation campaign "Har ghar Dastak" launched by the chief ministers.

health education with stressing on tooth decay and gum diseases and measures of prevention,

brushing technique demonstrations on models, and tobacco cessation. Our team especially

interns were highlighted about the eating patterns and food choices which cause tooth decay. We

have also conducted some treatment camps in which we included oral prophylaxis, extractions of

mobile teeth, restorations, and for complex treatment we refer camps participants to our college.








