#### REPORT

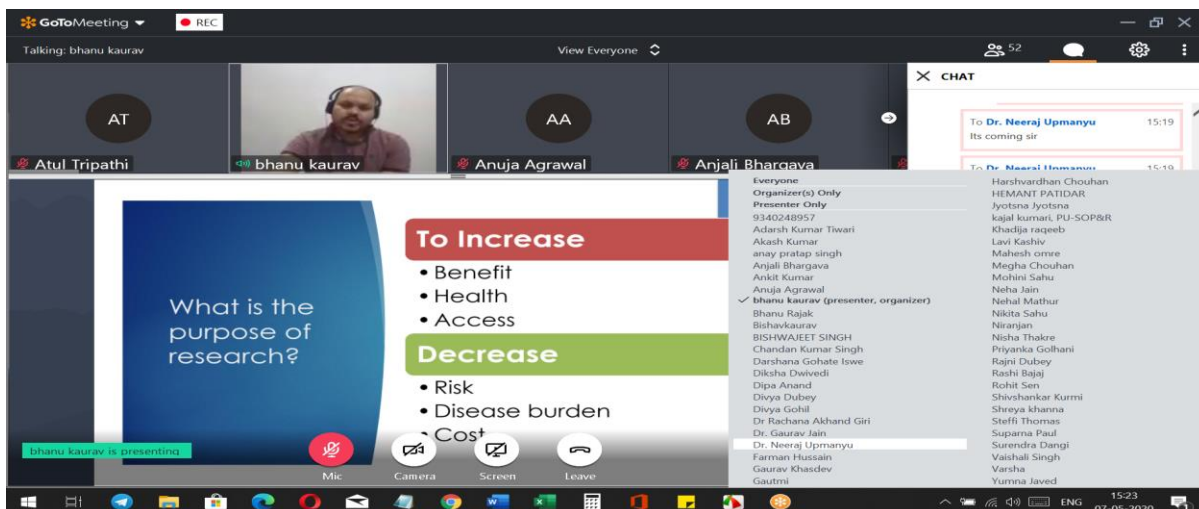
