Gp Capt (Dr.) Anil Kumar Dixit is the Dean of People's College of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, since 06 June 2020.

He passed M.B.B.S. in the year 1979 from the prestigious institute, *Gajara Raja Medical College, Gwalior*, affiliated to Jiwaji University. He was appointed as Demonstrator in the department of Preventive and Social Medicine in the same college, completed M.D. in *Preventive and Social Medicine* in the year 1983, was promoted as Lecturer in 1984 and thereafter served for a period of 3 years. Having an inclination for defense services, he joined Army Medical Corps (AMC) in the year 1987 and was seconded to Indian Air Force (IAF).

In his tenure of nearly 25 years in the IAF working as permanent commission, Dr Dixit served in different ranks, as Flight Lieutenant, Squadron Leader and Wing Commander, before promotion to the rank of Group Captain. As a specialist of Preventive and Social Medicine, he worked initially as graded and classified specialist at various prestigious flying IAF stations, as Health Officer including Air Force Academy, the most prestigious institute of IAF. He has also done Certificate courses in *Aviation Medicine* from prime Institute of Aerospace Medicine (IAM), Bangalore. He was appointed as health advisor to South Western Air Command (SWAC) and Western Air Command (WAC) before he opted for premature retirement in 2011. His selfless service with devotion and dedication was recognized by IAF, to award him the *'Commendation by Air Officer Commanding in Chief'* on 'Air Force Day' in 1998.

Dr Dixit after retirement from IAF, joined Rama Medical College, Ghaziabad (U.P.) as Professor and Head in Community Medicine Department in the year 2011, shifted to Teerthankar Mahaveer Medical College, Moradabad (U.P.) in the year 2014 and to People's College of Medical Sciences and Research Centre (PCMS & RC), Bhopal, in the year 2015 as Professor and Head. He was given additional responsibilities of Vice Dean for a period of nearly 3 years in PCMS & RC. Recognizing his administrative abilities, he has been promoted as the Dean of PCMS & RC, Bhopal on 06 Jun 2020.
