

Postgraduate students admitted to this course would be required to present one poster presentation to read one paper at a national/state conference and to present one research paper which should be published/accepted for publication/sent for publication during the period of his Postgraduate studies so as to make him eligible to appear at the Postgraduate degree examination as prescribed in the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations notified vide Gazette Notification dated 09/12/2009 (Clause 13.9).
8. The thesis shall be examined by a minimum of three examiners; one internal and two external examiners, who shall not be the examiners for Theory and Clinical examination. A candidate shall be allowed to appear for the Theory and Practical/Clinical examination only after the acceptance of the Thesis by the examiners."
9. The Medical college while making admission to the course shall ensure that:-



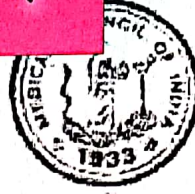

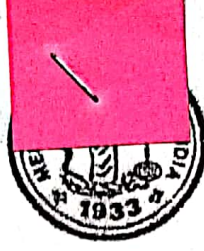
