Agenda of the Meeting: Revision of Scheme & Syllabus of B. Tech and M. Tech. (all branches) for new academic session 2019-20.

Discussion in the Meeting was concluded as;


All members are agreed to revised scheme and syllabus of B. Tech & M. Tech. all branches with following points.

1. Two week Induction program is introduced in B. Tech. for all students belonging to diverse backgrounds to adjust themselves in the new environment of Engineering.
2. Followed UGC and AICTE guidelines many new value added courses and non credit but mandatory subjects have been included i.e. Environmental Science, Disaster Management, Soft Skills, Professional Ethics, Constitution of India etc.
3. In new revised scheme credit based open elective and core elective subjects are also introduced in B. Tech VI, VII and VIII semester and M. Tech II and III semester to meet academic flexibility and NAAC, AICTE guidelines.
4. BOS members recommended to reduce total number of theory subjects in M. Tech third semester five to two as per guidelines.
5. Mandatory audit courses are included in I and II semester M. Tech. as per AICTE model curricular for M. Tech.

First of all BOS Chairman Ms. Raji N. Mishra welcomed all members and discussed the agenda of the meeting.

Agenda of the Meeting:

Compilation and submission of Revised Scheme and Syllabus of Diploma in Engineering (all branches) for new academic session 2019-20.

Discussion in the Meeting was concluded as

All members are identifying following salient points of revised scheme and syllabus of Diploma in Engineering.

1. Two week Induction program is introduced for all students belonging to diverse backgrounds to adjust themselves in the new environment of Engineering.
2. Diploma in Engineering Program is divided in two set: Set A (Civil Engineering and Computer Science Engineering) and Set B (Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Electronics and Communication Engineering) for smooth conduction of academic in first year.
3. It is noted during the development of revised curriculum, a concern was shared that in the present system, syllabus is heavily loaded and it is of utmost importance that the students entering into the engineering course should feel at ease by lowering the burden of syllabus and credits. So, total numbers of credits have been reduced from 200 to 192 as per AICTE model curricular guidelines. In continuation with the above, scheme syllabus of all semester of all courses are modified.
4. Common code DPE is adopted for common subjects who are applicable in all branches. DPE indicate Diploma in Engineering
5. Followed UGC and AICTE guidelines many new value added courses have been included i.e. Environmental Science and Disaster Management, Professional Skills, Development of Professional Ethics, Renewable Energy etc. with subject experts consultation.

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6. To meet with academic flexibility and NAAC past experience credit based open elective and core elective subjects are also introduced in the new revised scheme and syllabus.
7. Open Elective curriculum on E-commerce and E-Business, Rural Development and Community Services are included for holistic development developments.
8. For job preparation of various Private / Public Sector / Government organization / companies Soft Skills, Ethics, Numerical Aptitude, Reasoning, Competitive English and Interview Techniques are also included as contents in professional skill subjects.
9. To aware the real life working exposures of industry, revised syllabus has been designed where the students should undergo 15 days industrial training twice in their whole program, after third semester and fourth semester to have hands-on experience.
10. Students should mandatory to prepare reports, models and posters for exhibition which is a part of new syllabus.
